Registration:

Solo Competitions are open to all junior high school and high school students currently enrolled and active members of a WGASC unit member for the 2018 season. Interested participants can register on the WGASC website (www.wgasc.org) starting 2/1/18. Registration will close the Saturday prior to the day of the contest. The cost to register is \$20 (non-refundable) per division. Four divisions of competition will be offered:

Movement
Flag
Rifle
Sabre

Scheduling

A schedule will be posting on the WGASC website (www.wgasc.org) on the Tuesday prior to the day of the contest. Once posted the schedule is final. Each time slot is read left to right. Performances will alternate between divisions. Performers must check-in at the “unit check-in table” before their performance time. Performers who are late for their performance time will only be rescheduled at the discretion of the Contest Director.

Performance Soundtrack

The preferred media is mp3 player, smart phone or tablet. MP3 players should have a playlist with a single track. Performers will only be able to do sound checks during the hour before the solo competition begins. Restarts due to music problems will be solely at the discretion of the judge.

Division Rules

- Performance space is 30'x30'. This size may vary due unforeseen facilities obstructions.
- Due to varied vertical spaces, equipment choreography should be limited to a “quad toss” height.
- Performance time minimum is 1:00 and maximum is 1:30.
- Equipment soloists may not put their equipment down at any time during the performane.
- Solos will be judged using the IA Equipment or IA Movement sheet.

Spectators

Spectators will be allowed into the Solo Competition space free of charge. Attendance or participation at the Solo Competition does not grant entry to the main performance arena.

Awards

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards will be given. An awards ceremony will be scheduled following the the last solo performance of the day.
- The top three performances in each division will receive the opportunity to compete in a virtual competition (via the e-adjudicate platform) including the top three division winners from all WGASC Signature shows. The 1st place division winner from the virtual competition will receive the opportunity to perform in exhibition at WGASC Championships at UC Irvine on 4/22/18.
