Staff and Performer Credential Policy: All spectators, staff, volunteers, and performers entering the competition gym must display an approved credential issued by WGASC.

Accepted credentials:

- Ensemble Director Badge

- VIP Badge
- Advisory Board Badge
- Season Pass Badge (wristband required)
- Staff / Volunteer Wristbands (provided at Ensemble Check-In)
- Performer Wristband

Reminders:

- Credentials must be visible
- Sharing or transferring credentials is not permitted

Spectator Ticket Policy: All spectators attending this event must hold a valid ticket (wristband), available for purchase at the Box Office, and wear this Spectator Wristband to enter the competition gym. It is the responsibility of the ticket holder to be inside the gym and seated prior to the scheduled performance time; spectators are strongly encouraged to arrive at least 15 minutes before the performance they wish to see. Late entry may be delayed until an appropriate break in performances.

Seating Policy: Front side seating is open to any individual with a WGASC issued credential (as described above). This includes performers. If seating becomes limited, performers may be asked to move to the back side seating area. Ensemble Directors, staff, volunteers, and spectators with a WGASC issued badge or wristband will be permitted to stay seated in the front side seating area.
